Poster Preparation Guidelines

Poster presenters must send the following materials to submissions-pracedays@prace-ri.eu by **15 February 2021, EOB**:

Video presentation

- The video of your poster presentation (maximum 5 minutes) should include the key messages of the research work displayed on your poster
- Video File Name: LAST NAME-First Name (example: LANG-Silke)
- Always use a virtual background, preferably the EHPCSW 2021 background we provided you with. Alternatively, you can use the virtual background of your organisation. Please do not use other images, nor blur the background.
- **Please follow the video recording guidelines provided separately**

Format and size

- The Poster should be submitted in **two formats**:
 - **First Format**: portrait orientation and should be submitted as a high-resolution PDF (300dpi recommended). **Posters that do not use the poster template we provided cannot be uploaded to the Poster Session**
 - **Second Format**: Posters should be submitted as 1200 x 675 .jpg file (landscape orientation)
 - **File name**: Poster-LAST NAME-First Name (example: Poster-LANG-Silke)

Title

- The title of the poster should appear at the top of your poster

Authors and affiliations

- Below the title, the main contributing poster authors should be included with their affiliations (*this list should ideally not be longer than two lines on the poster*)
- Author affiliation logos may appear in the same general area of the poster

Acknowledgements

- If your project was supported by PRACE, the text "*The Implementation Phase of PRACE receives funding from the EU's Horizon 2020 Research and Innovation Programme (2014-2020) under grant agreement 823767*" should appear at the very bottom of the poster in small print together **with the EU flag**.
- The graphics are available for download at http://europa.eu/about-eu/basic-information/symbols/flag/index_en.htm
- If your project was supported by another funding organisation, please include the appropriate acknowledgements.



General good practise guidelines for posters

- Stick to one font type in your poster and use two or at most three font sizes throughout your poster
- Ensure that any poster diagrams are of as high quality as possible (to prevent pixilation). 300 dpi is recommended.
- Ensure that any text appearing in any diagrams you include is readable and of similar size to your lowest poster font size



If we do not receive the requested materials by **Monday 15 February 2021, EOB**, we cannot guarantee that your poster will be displayed in the digital Poster Session.

Poster display – dedicated Poster Session

During the entire event, all posters will be digitally available for viewing and networking. The Poster authors **will be requested** to be present for live chats with participants and the PRACEdays21 Best Poster Award Selection Committee in a dedicated meeting room at their respective poster booth during the **dedicated Poster Session** on **Tuesday 23 March and Wednesday 24 March, from 16:00 to 17:00 (CET)**.

Publication

In co-operation with the author, PRACE will publish the abstracts and poster of the selected posters on the conference webpage of the PRACE website together with details of the presenter (name, institution, country, short biography)
