Daniel will present current and upcoming opportunities at the EuroHPC JU to apply for R&D&I grants. The JU has recently launched an open call for European Centres of Excellence for HPC Applications (CoEs) and is accepting submissions for proposals which will support the transition towards the exascale and post -exascale era.

Daniel will describe how the JU implements National Competence Centres for HPC (NCCs), which support SMEs, industry and public bodies to access HPC resources, to take up HPC in present and forthcoming business models and to widen the use of HPC in Europe. The JU is also committed to supporting coordination and networking within and between several major initiatives including the CoEs and NCCs. Moreover, the JU provides education opportunities through a new pan-European MSc Programme in HPC for European students to promote academic excellence and to train the next generation of European HPC experts.
