# What is Blog?

A web site on which an individual or group of users record opinions, information



Get superior content marketing education so you can build a remarkable online presence.







# Who will create the content of the SoHPC blog?

We start with creating posts introducing you which will be prepared during this week.



### What kind of posts and how many?

- Each student should create at least 3 posts
  - Introduction
  - Update
  - ► Final results



You are encouradged to update as frequently as you want.

You can join and write posts together, or post individually.




#### **Timeline**

- Introduction by July 21
- Update by August 10
- Final report by August 31









# Expectations and standards Blog style

- All posts have to be in English
- ▶ Posts should be between 300 700 words
- Use paragraphs and subtitles/headings
- Choose an interesting title that piques the interests of the audience
- Avoid emoticons
- Write with full words and sentences, avoid mobile phone speak
- Use bold to highlight, never use all capitals
- ▶ Use a spellchecker
- All images need to have caption



# Expectations and standards Blog content

- Try to reference PRACE and Summer of HPC positively
- Avoid any content containing
  - ▶ Racist, hateful, homophobic, slanderous, insulting, or life-threatening messages
  - ▶ Serious, unproven or inaccurate accusations against individuals or organizations
  - ► Aggreasive, coars, violent, obscene, or pornographic comments
- ► Take care that your links are from reputable sources and that linked sites do not contravene the above content guidelines



# Copyright referencing and consent

- Be aware of copyright
  - ▶ Use multimedia that is your own
  - Obtain consent to use other people's multimedia
  - ▶ Cite the original source
  - ▶ Creative commons material is often freely available
- Do not quote or reference PRACE partners or people without prior consent
- Obtain consent from those featured in your own multimedia
- Reference academic work approprietaly





#### Performance

Summer of HPC uses Google Analytics to measure the impact of blogging



Google Analytics monitors the **number of visitors** to the blog, their **location**, source of **referral**, and **engagement** on the page.

# Criteria for winning the HPC Ambassador Award What counts?

- Biography
- Blog posts
- Statement self written, why you feel you should win
- Student vote
- Number of unique visitors to your blog posts
- Number of times you were the week's top post





# The weight of different evaluation criteria

Criteria	Description	Weight
Blog	Assesment of the quality of applicants blog posts	high
Statement	Assesment of the commitment of the participant to the HPC ambassador role	high
Reach	Sum of the unique visitors of the applicants blog posts	high
Student vote	Ranking at the fellow student's vote	medium
Top post	Number of times the applicants posts were the weekly top post	low





### Blog: saving and submitting for moderating

#### **Different statuses**


- Draft is for when you are writting and don't want to submit yet
- ► Submit For Review is for when you want to send it to moderators for review and to be published
- ► Editing Required is the status that a moderator will select when they want you to make changes





#### Saving and submitting for moderating

- Before hitting the Save as Draft button always decide on the status
- If you want to move forward in the process change status before hitting Save as Draft





# What will the moderating team do?

- The moderator team will read every post
- They will either
  - ► Approve the post for publication and publish it
  - Or make recommendations or editorial comments
  - ➤ You can respond to those comments, make changes and resubmit for review again
- Moderators are automatically notified of changes in post status
- Posters will be notifiedby email of changes to the post status for their own posts

#### Editorial comments and meta data

- Underneath of all posts is an area called Editorial Comments
- You can make comments for the Moderators to see here e.g. Please pay special attention to paragraph one
- Moderators will add comments here if they want to make changes and change the status to editing required
- You will receive an e-mail with notification of these comments
- Once you have made your edits you can resubmit for review
- There is also Editorial Metadata
  - Needs Photo/Media
  - Needs Technical Review
  - Needs Referral
  - Needs Language Review
- Moderators will use this to refer the post to the moderator with the appropriate skills



# Your first blog post? Introduce yourself with the help of your fellow students!

#### Participants page has to contain:

Name, age, area and level of study, university which the student attends, SoHPC location, project name

#### And loads of other fun and entertaining content like:

- Quote by fellow student about you
- Explaining why you have applied
- Your first reaction when you found out you were selected
- ► Your hobbies, favourite leisure time activity,...

#### Prepare for:

Shooting short introductory video that will be embedded to the post
