

# EuroHPC BoF at EuroHPC Summit Week 2019 Poznan (Poland)

## **Title: “The EuroHPC Infrastructure and Research & Innovation Pillars”**

The EuroHPC Joint Undertaking was initiated in October 2018 with ambitious goals and an aggressive timeframe that aims to bring Europe on the forefront of HPC worldwide. The EuroHPC BoF will present in detail the work that the JU has achieved during these months in particular for what concerns the two strategic pillars of Infrastructure development and Research & Innovation. The BoF is split in three parts: In the first part, officials of the European Commission will introduce the two action pillars and provide further details of the JU activities, essentially elaborating on the plenary presentation that will be given in the Tuesday morning session. The talks will be followed by two one-hour open sessions organized, by the respective official advisory groups of the JU, namely INFRAG and RIAG. The two groups will present their structure, their mandate and the work performed so far, along with their future workplans. They will also open the floor for interaction with the participating audience with the goal to collect input from the European HPC stakeholders.

- Inform audience of upcoming calls and important future milestones
- Present to the audience the two JU advisory groups; facilitate their interaction with the broader public and initiate discussions with the European HPC User Communities.
